





Following are the questions for online student satisfaction survey from 3,690 students with regard to teaching learning process.





- 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as shows Excellent(19 %), Very good (58%) and good (23%)
- 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers shows Always fair (63%) and Usually fair (37%).
- 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you shows 97 % by Every time and 3% Usually
- 7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students shows Regularly (92%), Often (6%) and Sometimes(3%).
- 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth shows Significantly (88%), Very well (11%) and Moderately (1%)
- 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow shows Strongly agree (85%), Agree (15%).
