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Institutional Ethics

Ethical dimensions of an Educational Institution cannot be ignored and it has a significant impact on society at large.

1. Areas for Ethical applications

- a) Day to day administration
- b) Teaching – learning-Evaluation
- c) Research and Project consultancy
- d) Professional conduct

2. Constitution / Members of the Committee:

The Ethics Committee shall consist of a Chairman and three other members as detailed below:

Member Secretary	Convener of the Research Committee
Members	Any Two Senior faculty members as nominated by the Principal

3. Role of Institutional Ethical Committee

- a) Establishing procedures to deal with ethical deviations / professional misconduct
- b) Assist the Unfair means Committee to investigate into reported cases
- c) Support the Vigilance squad to maintain overall dignity, discipline and decorum of the institution

- d) To ensure protection and safety of whistle blowers and acknowledge their contribution in maintaining the ethical standards

4. Ethics Policy

Our ethics policy warrants ability to discern right from wrong, good from evil, and the commitment to do what is right, good and proper for each individual within the College.

4.1 Academic Ethics
